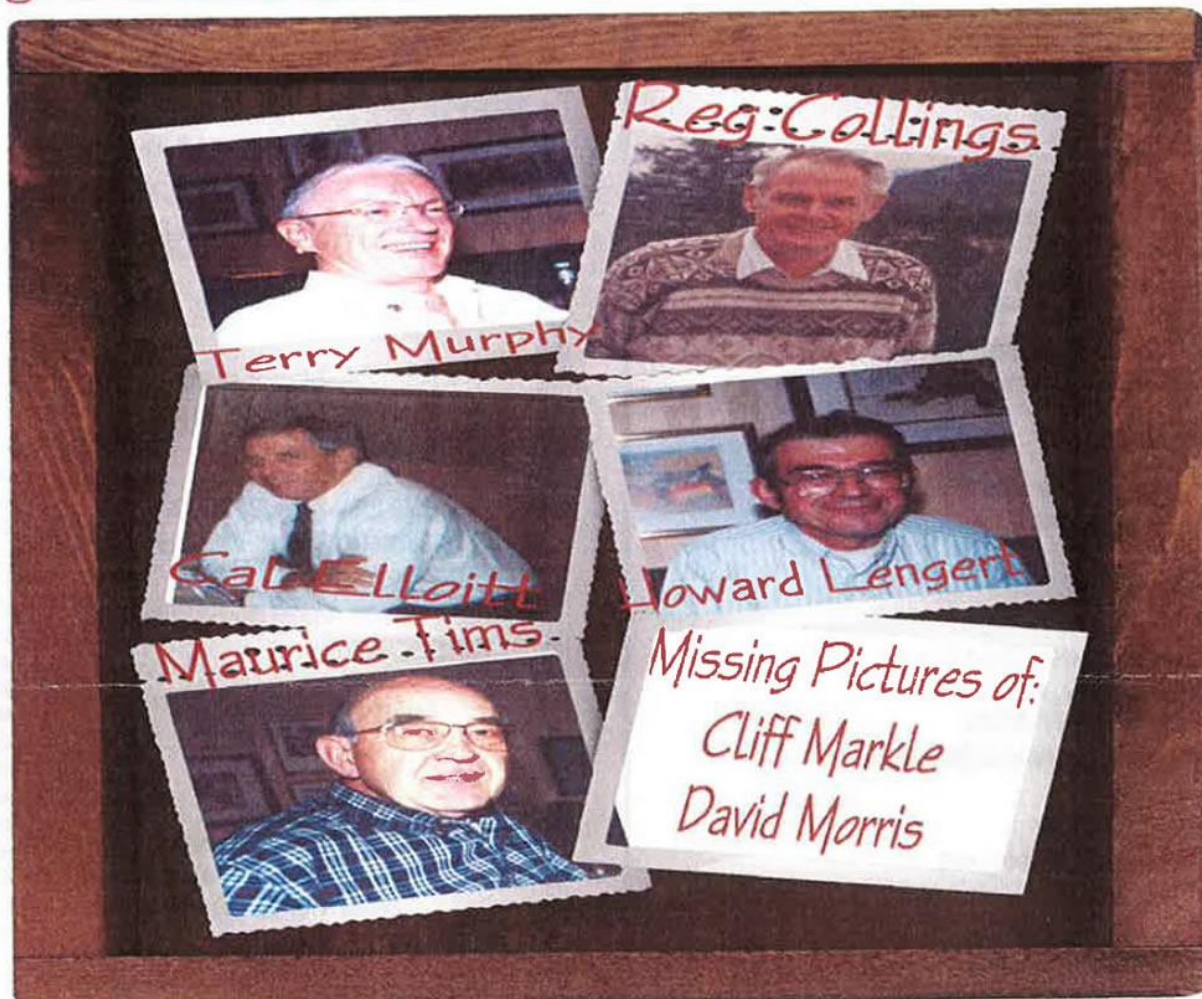

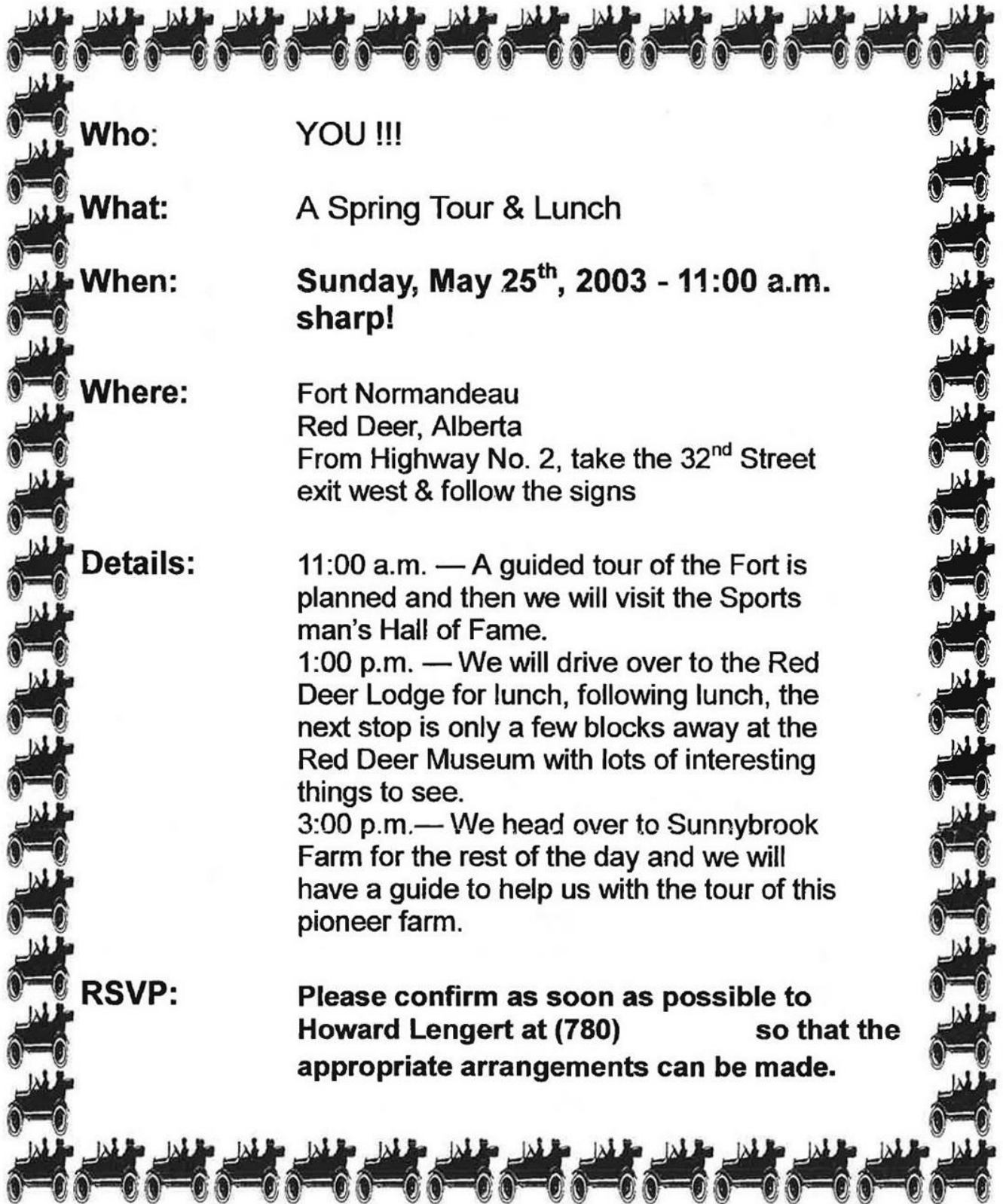

APRIL SOUTH EVENT



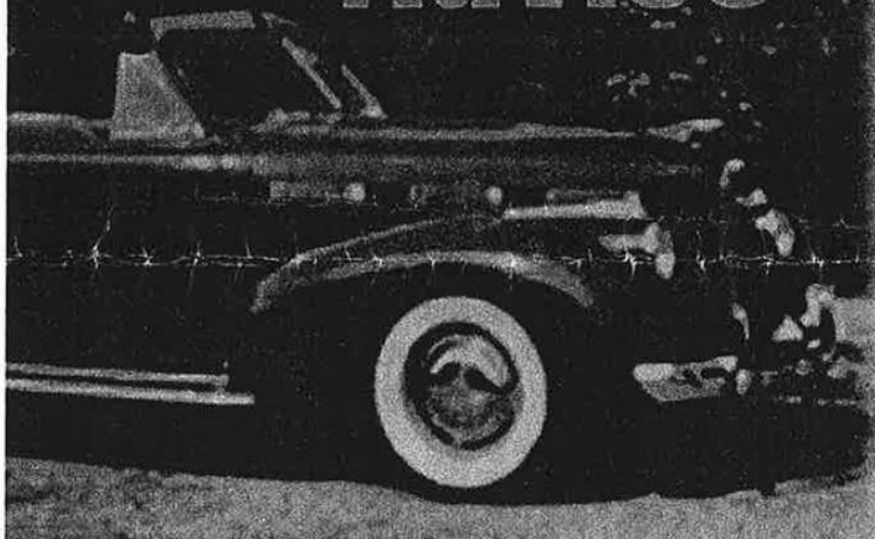
